# Formatting

As you might expect when dealing with anything other than plain text, formatting becomes an issue. I do everything in Google Docs and export the components of this package into Word and PDF

As you transfer everything to your favorite word processor or web editor you'll probably have to make some small design tweaks to clean everything up.

You'll also want to double-check the table of contents to make sure the page numbers line up.

If you don't have a Word processor program, here's a free open source one you can use to edit the document and turn it into a PDF file.
